School Overview

Pui Ching Middle School (PCMS) was founded in Guangzhou, China by Baptist Convention in 1889. It branched out to Hong Kong in 1933, and later during WWII, the school branched out again to Macau due to the Japanese occupation of Hong Kong. In 1952, with the financial support of the late parent, Mr. Ho Jin and the donation of alumni, parents, students and staffs, the school finally bought a permanent campus and had gradually developed into its present state. Nowadays, PCMS is a non-profit private Christian school in Macau, consisting of kindergarten (K1-K3), primary (P1-P6), and secondary (S1-S6) sections all in one campus.

School Features

Academic Focus

In accordance with the school motto “Utmost Goodness, Utmost Righteousness”, PCMS endeavors to provide quality education and to ensure a balanced development in the six aspects of education: moral conduct, wisdom, physical development, social concern, aesthetic and spiritual growth.

Since there is no public examination system in Macau so far, one of the main objectives of the school-based curriculum and extra-curricular activities is that all students are properly prepared for college studies around the globe.

Curriculum

The academic calendar is organized on a trimester schedule, with approximately 40 school weeks per year. The core subjects of the Secondary curriculum include Language (Chinese & English), Mathematics, Information Technology, Physical Education, Fine Arts and Bible Study. By the final year of Junior high school (S3), the students have already taken introductory courses in History, Geography, Physics, Chemistry and Biology. In Senior high school (S4-S6), the curriculum is divided into 3 academic streams, which are *Science*, *Arts*, and *Liberal Arts & Science*.

Other Features

Cambridge English School

Certified as the 1st Cambridge English School in Asia in June, 2014. Cambridge English Schools are affiliated to the Cambridge English Language Assessment Board and Cambridge University Press, providing Cambridge English examinations and teaching resources to member schools.

Lego STEM Laboratory

The 1st in-house Lego STEM Laboratory among primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong and Macau, opened in March, 2016. The laboratory aims to raise students' interest in innovations and to nurture talents through hand-on experience with applied technology.

FabLab

Approved by the Center for Bits and Atoms of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, FabLab Pui Ching became a member of the international Fab Lab network in August, 2016 (1st in Hong Kong and Macau, and 2nd among secondary schools in China).

Chinese Culture Art Gallery

The one of a kind, in-house Gallery houses a large collection of prehistoric to contemporary Chinese artifacts and cultural relics, which provide authentic learning materials for our school-based humanities education.

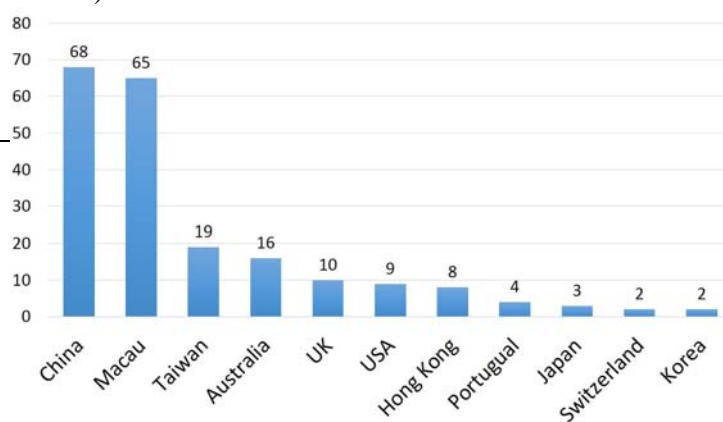
PMCS applies 100-point grading scale in all subjects, and the passing mark is 60. Individual ranking in class is not reported and the academic result is reported in following ways:
